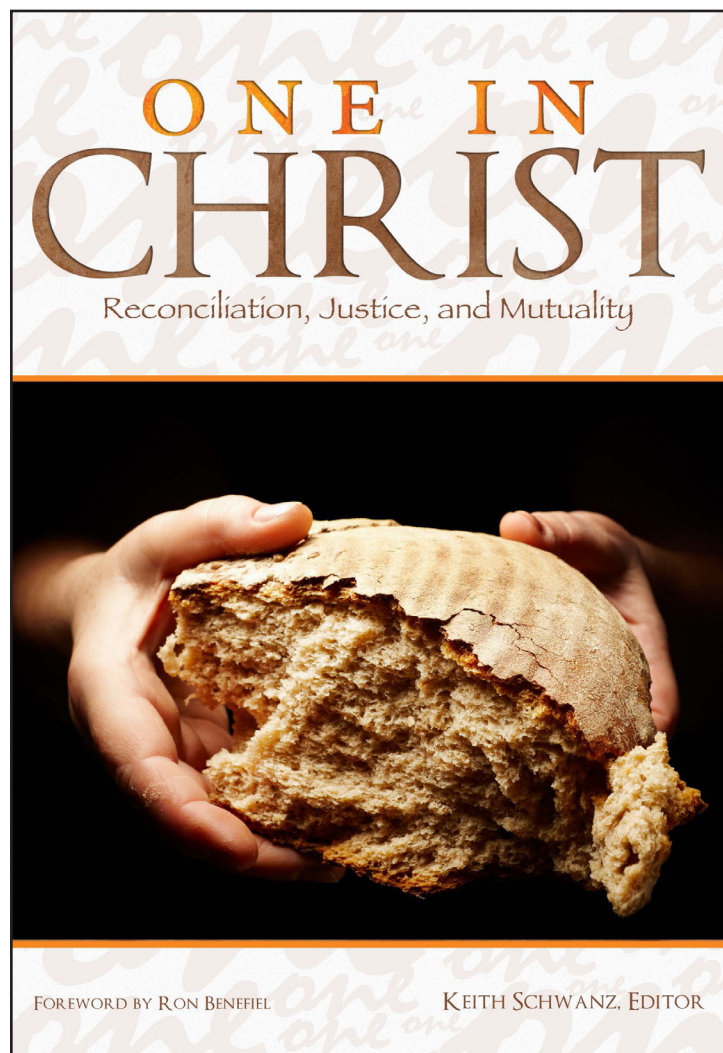

Paul had good news for the church in Galatia: “There is no longer Jew or Greek ... slave or free ... male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus” (Gal. 3:28).
